RED CROSS SHELTERS REMAIN OPEN FOR RESIDENTS AFFECTED BY HIGH SURF

HONOLULU, HI (December 7, 2009) – The American Red Cross continues to staff shelters at the following locations:

Waianae District Park	81-601 Farrington Hwy, Waianae
Queen Liliuokalani Church	66-090 Kam Hwy, Haleiwa
Sunset Beach Recreation Center	59-530 Kamehameha Hwy

These shelters opened at 2 PM on Sunday and will stay open as long as there is a need for people to seek shelter from this hazard. The Red Cross is working closely with the Department of Emergency Management and the Humane Society to provide safe shelter in these areas for people who need to evacuate.

As of Sunday evening we reported 6 people at Waianae District Park Shelter plus 3 dogs and 4 cats at the Hawaiian Humane Society pet shelter and 1 person at Liliuokalani Church.

The Red Cross is a non-profit humanitarian organization which provides assistance for immediate emergency needs. All Red Cross assistance to disaster victims is free.
