RED CROSS RESPONDING FLOODING

HONOLULU, June 6, 2011 -Volunteers with the American Red Cross are responding to residential flooding after the heavy thunderstorms this weekend in the Waihee Valley, Waiahole and Kahana Valley areas. Yesterday morning, Red Cross disaster volunteers were in the affected areas assessing the flood damage. Volunteers are heading to the scene, again, to meet with affected residents and ensure their immediate emergency needs are met and clean up kits will be distributed when appropriate. Caseworkers will continue to follow up with anyone affected in the coming weeks to provide referrals, guidance or additional assistance as needed to help with the recovery process.

The Red Cross encourages all families to make a disaster plan to include an evacuation plan with two different routes of escape, a communications plan to help families reconnect after disaster and a disaster supplies kit that is readily available to aid in a quick evacuation. Information on developing a family plan is available to the public at www.redcross.org, or a brochure can be requested by calling 734-2101.
