

## **Nurse Assistant “One Day” Review Course**

This class will identify and review the essential information and skills that a Nurse Assistant is required to have in order to care for residents in a nursing home. The course was designed for candidates planning to take the State of Hawaii Nurse Assistant Competency Evaluation Exam to become a CNA. To be eligible, you must have done one of the following and provide proof at the time of registration:

- Must have completed a Nurse Assistant Training course from a State-Approved School within the last 6 months and/or
- Has taken and failed the competency evaluation exam one or more times.

The one day course takes place in the Red Cross Headquarters Chapter bldg. at 4155 Diamond Head Rd. from 8am to 4:30pm. The class is scheduled once per month, call or walk-in for a schedule and to register. The cost is \$110 and includes a skill book.

Please be sure to arrive for the class promptly at the start time. There is a strict policy of no refunds or transferring enforced for the Review course if you are unable to attend.
